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Be prepared	Put yourself between danger and your students
Lesson plan	
Equipment	Proper use of the megaphone
Safety boat	Speak to class from upwind
Radio check	Proper use of safety position
Attitude	Keep active... hustle
Take attendance	Look around all the time
Five methods of teaching	Coach each student equally
Square course/ marks	Keep instructions short & rich in information
Team teach	
Safety boat must be on the water before students leave dock	Repeat instructions
Check rigging of boats before they leave	Make it FUN!
Take control of the group	Use student's names
Have a "briefing" before you leave dock	Always check a capsized boat
Define drills	Have a back-up plan
Constantly count your students	Use radios on the water for communication (turn them on!)
Anticipate actions of the wind	Always plan one step ahead
Anticipate actions of your students	Positive reinforcement (thumbs up!)
Use whistle and hand signals	Spread instructor boats out
Don't anchor unless you can quickly toss	Do not be negligent
Define areas that the students should sail	Debrief
Define tasks the students should do
