Commodore's Report-Georgi Munger:

Commodore Munger asked that clubs prepare an updated fleet census which NJYRA will summarize to gain a current view of club fleets. The commodore announced an initiative to reach out to clubs in our geographic area that are not members. She has asked for a contact list from US Sailing.

US Sailing Dues are heavily discounted for NJYRA members and member clubs should take advantage of this opportunity.

The commodore mentioned that Andy Tim is the third member of the C420 States Committee. She also discussed the concept of creating a Youth Laser State Championship with a charter similar to the C420 States charter. It was emphasized that the idea if brought to reality would not conflict with the District 10 Championship. The venue must be ready to handle 60-70 boats. Georgi will reach out to other nearby YRA (BBYRA, et al.) to solicit interest.

Franz Schneider (our Area C rep.) mentioned the concern about attendance at Ladder Events by Area C members. He asked that



NJYRA discuss and provide suggestions. Some suggestions that were put forward:

- 1. For Adam's trophy hold an NJYRA Woman's Championship.
- 2. Have a similar NJYRA Championship for Sear's and O'Day.

- LBI club in summer for LBI clubs.
- LHYC in early fall for lake clubs

Club officers and members will be invited as quests.

A sub-committee will be formed to review the High Point Trophy criteria. An idea was proposed to hold a NJYRA Team Race as a component of the High Point Trophy with three skippers from each club as a team.

The meeting was adjourned at 2110.
