Jr. Program Discussion

At 2030 a roundtable discussion of ways to improve Jr. Programs was begun. Georgi Munger moderated the discussion. She cited a US Sailing presentation in which three very different types of programs were discussed:

 A Minnesota program for 750 kids with 18 420, 18 Club 420, many Optis and Sonars.



- The American YC in YC which has over 1000 members and draws from its membership only.
- Balboa YC which makes extensive use of travel to other clubs.

The key point is that every club is different but your club must have a clear mission and goal for its Jr. Program. Especially you must have a clear understanding of your target audience.

You must have a highly qualified instructor staff-both in sailing and people skills. This is another reason to nurture your older juniors. Often jobs and internships compete with an instructor job.

Some realities:

In 1980 participation 12.8 which went to 2.9 in 2009. Google access of junior sailing dropped 40%.

Focus on "serious racers" needs to change: 65% of juniors are learners, 25% are occasional racers and only 10% are the hard-core racers.

Plan on other activities in your Jr. Program

- 1. Paddleboards
- 2. Windsurfers
- 3. Big boat sails with Senior Members
- 4. Kayaking
- 5. Milk Carton boats
- 6. Socials

The meeting was adjourned at 2120.
